## REQUIREMENTS FOR SWIMMING POOLS

§ 1203. Special Yard Requirements. [Ord. 2007-2, 5/22/2007] In addition to the yard requirements specified in each zoning district, the following yard requirements shall apply in all zoning districts to the applicable circumstances described below:

- A. Corner lots. Corner lots shall provide front yards on each street frontage. The remaining two yards shall constitute side yards. There shall be no rear yard required.
- B. Nonconforming lots of record: See § 1503.
- C. Accessory structures. In all zoning districts, the following regulations shall apply to accessory structures:
  - (1) Private swimming pools accessory to a dwelling.
    - (a) Swimming pools accessory to a dwelling shall be located at least 10 feet from the dwelling or any property line.

      Swimming pools shall not be permitted in the front yard. All swimming pools and the equipment necessary for maintaining the pool shall be completely enclosed by a fence that is at least four feet in height and that has a self-closing and self-latching gate. The dwelling may constitute a part of the required enclosure.
    - (b) For an aboveground swimming pool that is completely enclosed by a railing around the entire perimeter, where the combined height of the pool and railing is at least four feet above the adjacent ground level at all points, and that has a self-latching retractable ladder, the pool shall not be required to be fenced. All other aboveground swimming pools shall be fenced in accordance with the requirements of this Subsection C(1).
