III. Reports:

- A. Secretary's Report:
 - 1. Minutes from regular township meeting February 17, 2015 and minutes from Firemen's meeting February 25, 2015. Anthony motions to accept minutes as written. Tom seconds.

Cherry Valley station has received there used 1996 Pierce Fire Engine. The engine will be In service within the next week or two. Cash Bash April 25, 2015.

F. Supervisors report

1. Roads-Material-Sweeper. This winter has left many of the roads in muddy conditions, potholes, damaged shoulders, etc. Trouble getting limestone delivered, hot asphalt not available yet, using winter mix for the potholes. We are on schedule for street sweeping starting April 20 for two weeks.

VII. 1.New Business. Access agreement between Smith Twp and Cyprus Amax Minerals Co. Agree-Ment to go on Smith's property. AZC Soil Langeloth on-site assessment and remediation work Performed by Cyprus under PA DEP Consent Order and Agreement. Tim motions to sign Assessment agreement. Anthony seconds. Carried.

2.Anthony talked to Max Environmental about impoundment 3. Apply for permits. Wants to Run 24-7. Will have a public meeting. Part of our Agreement from .50 cents to \$1.00 a ton. Anthony motions to accept the community benefit fee offered by Max Environment Tech-Nologies based upon their letter to the township March 16, 2015 for submission as part of Their application to the Pennsylvania Dept. of Environmental Protection for Landfill #3. Anthony makes that motion. Tim seconds. Motion carried unanimously.

Public comments:

Mark Sarracino. Keep a close eye on Sewage Authority. Don't put on back burner. They want to put back rate increase. They want residents to pay for all their projects.

Lisa Gregg. At Firemen's meeting, a call came in for medical. Police officer didn't go. Ambulance would Advise us if general illness, fall, etc. We are only one who gets these call. Chief talked to 911. He will look Into that. Chief recommends to add medical on policy and procedures.

Carol Long. What does township provide moneywise for firemen? Tom. Supervisors put on 2 mils resulting in \$40,000. a year to pay for new fire truck, leased Cherry Valley buildings for second fire station for \$1.00 for 25 years, paid \$14,000 for insulation to help with the heating, pay Workmans comp. \$14,000, pays for all diesel fuel, gets \$21,000 from foreign fire insurance through the township, Supervisors to relinquish \$60,000 out of Impact fee money, supervisors hope to lease some land in the near future in the Smith Township Industrial Park for \$1.00 to build a new station. We are trying to work with them. Carol asked about bringing Comcast into Smith. Contact - Dan Riley. Tom said have him call one of the supervisors. Carol also sent pictures showing water in her yard. Carol contacted PA American water. They said it's storm water. Anthony checked. Break in line. We will fix it. Robert Okavitch. Did you decide if we can have a K-9 bank account set up for contributions that come in. Anthony. We will have to talk to auditors first. What if K-9 doesn't go through? Will have to send a letter with their money back. RJ wants to apply for grants. A lot of free money out there. Can we also have the VFW unlock these back doors when we have our meeting? If something happens, we can get out. Larry Griffith had house fire. Slovan put fire out. He's complaining that they didn't call Burgettstown F.D. Burgettstown F.D. wants to know why Slovan F.D. never calls them for backup. Had a big discussion about this. Basically came down to Burgettstown F.D. not having much training.

Anthony motions to adjourn meeting at 8:26 pm. Tim seconds. Meeting adjourned.
