- A. Secretary's Report:

 - 1.PA American Water putting fire hydrant on Joffre-Bulger Road. Also one on Route 18 Between Bavington and Pepsi Cola Roadhouse.  - 3.GAI Consultant for ETC Northeast Pipeline. Will submit application for Water Obstruction And Encroachment General Permit. Project name Revolution Cryo Plant Project.
 - 4.S & K Energy. Requesting bond release for 36.3 acres on Moore mine SMP#63050101. Bond Was made December 16, 2005. Total bond held \$67,720.00. They backfilled and graded. Was Completed in April 2009. Richard and Bonnie Moore said a water problem still exists. Zoning Officer, Bill Tohey suggested Supervisors turn down the request to release the bond and inform the DEP, until the water situation is taken care of. Supervisors will inform DEP by letter.

- 3. James Harshman, Township Engineer. Received letters on Fox Natural Gas Processing Plant. Has to have conditional use application. On hold for now. Rover Gas Compressor Station. Submitted application. Under review. Must establish date for Conditional Use Hearing ETC Project. Rover no application yet. Updated Flood Plain Ordinance. Needs to be adopted By September 30th. Anthony motions to advertise for Flood Plain Ordinance. Tim seconds. Carried. This is critical so that residents will be eligible for flood insurance.
- 4. Solicitor letter to supervisors. There was an issue at our Planning Commission meeting. Bill Tohey is our Code Enforcement Officer and also works for MarkWest, which could Become a conflict of interest. Solicitor suggests Bill not function as Zoning and Code Enforcement officer for Oil and Gas Applications, but on all other matters, there is no problem. Our Engineering Firm has a person that works with them on Zoning. It was suggested for now with The applications that we have started let that person work with Harshman Engineers. Bill Tohey is in agreement with this. Dan Petricca stated that he would be interested in the Zoning Officer position. Anthony motioned to advertise if needed at a later date. Tim seconds. Motion Carried.
- 5. Harshman Engineer. Code Enforcement Officer on an as needed basis. Dan Petricca requested he be appointed to the job. We will appoint someone next meeting. Anthony Motions to hire as needed Code Enforcement officer next meeting. Tim Seconds. Carried. Solicitors report. Gary Sweat.
