Meeting was called to order by Chairman Tom Schilinski at 6:01 pm. Supervisors present Robert "RC" Cassidy, Vice Chairman, Tim Green, Secretary. Secretary's Report Tim Green:

*Resolution #2019-6R Census 2020. To establish a complete count committee. Make people aware. Smith Township had an 83% response In 2010. 321 did not respond. Affects monies you get for schools, grants, etc. Tim motions to pass Resolution #2019-6R. RC seconds. Motion carried.

*Resolution #2019-7R Retaining Local Share Account program. Tim motions to pass Resolution #2019-7R. RC seconds. Motion carried.

*Resolution #2019-8R Amend Right To Know Law – relief from vexatious requestors.

*Mike Platek 2nd assistant chief for SVFD. Fire Department needs signs put up on 18 for new firehouse. State Road. Tom will make a call to Penn Dot and ask permission. They will have someone come out to look at it. Also wanted to know if we could paint the curbs yellow by old firehouse so cars don't park where it interferes with emergency vehicles going in and out of station. Truck traffic horrible by Grandma Mary's. Had 3 accidents there in a week or two. Trucks flying. Can we check on False alarm ordinance. Getting a lot of false alarms.
