### **Secretary's Report Tim Green:**

\*Minutes from regular meeting 5/20/19. RC motions to accept minutes as written. Tom seconds. Carried.

### **\*Secretary-Treasurer's Report Michele Meneely:**

\*Revenues - \$168,701.68 Expenditures - \$91,408.69 Bank Balances – General Fund - \$150,617.95 Payroll - \$11581.33. ### **Police Report Chief LaRue:**

\*Traffic Study. Location: Slovan Volunteer Fire Dept. (Smith Township State Road SB). Speed percentile: 50% - 31.3 mph; 85% =35.6 mph. Total vehicle volume 23,640. 50 Violators equivalent to 33.9% of Volume.

\*Tetra Tech. Harmon Creek Plant to Houston. MarkWest intends to file for a Chapter 105 permit application to install 2 20" natural gas transmission pipelines.

\*Tetra Tech. Bare tank site modification. 20 verticle 350 BB tanks. Bavington Road. Updating old permit. Same staging area. Solicitor suggests to find out if they are expanding.

\*GAI Consultants. Tri State Corridor pipeline. Going through Jefferson, Cross Creek, Smith and Robinson Township. Will hook onto Brooke County WV.

\*Resolution 2019-9R. The Smith Township Supervisors are initiating the process to consider entering into a lease agreement with the United States Postal Service for property at 105 Smith Park Drive Slovan PA 15078. Upon final execution, the lease shall be deemed binding. Tim motions to pass Resolutuion 2019-9R. RC seconds. Motion carried.
