### **Secretary's Report Tim Green:**

\*Minutes from regular meeting 8/19/19. RC motions to accept minutes as written. Tom seconds. Carried.

### **\*Secretary-Treasurer's Report Michele Meneely:**

\*Revenues - \$126,886.68 Expenditures - \$169,575.27 Bank Balances – General Fund - \$90,225.89. Payroll - \$9,230.01. Tim motions to accept Treasurer's report and pay all bills except for Green's Towing and Cassidy Signs. RC seconds. Carried. Tim motions to pay Cassidy Signs bills. Tom seconds. RC abstains. Carried. RC motions to pay Green Towing bills. Tom seconds. Tim abstains. Carried.

\*RC. The Burgettstown Borough recognized our full time officer, Mike Pasquale on August 28, 2019. He was off duty and a call came in regarding a child in a tree swing with the rope caught around his neck. He got the rope off and did CPR on him until paramedics arrived.
