Secretary's Report Tim Green:

*Small Flow Sewage Treatment Facility Agreement. Brandon Riggle and 66 Station Street. They failed a dye test. We can do this, but have to pass for it to be legal. Will table for further review.

*Special meeting to be announced to hire a new road crew employee. Deb will put an ad in the Observer Reporter regarding the special meeting. Tim motions to advertise help wanted in the Observer. RC seconds. Motion carried.

*Need to set time for Reorganization and regular meeting in January. 5:30 Reorganization meeting with Regular meeting to immediately follow. Monday, January 3, 2022. January 4, 2022 at 7pm will be the Auditors meeting at the Smith Township Municipal Complex.

*We need to appoint an auditor at the Reorganization meeting January 3rd.

Solicitors report Michael Cruny: Absent

*Allison Road. Board took action back in 2009. Stephanie from Penn Dot sent over resolution but it was never filed with the Clerk of Courts. Michael Cruny filed it. Has to wait 30 days for review period. Should be back by the end of this month. We can then send that over to PennDOT and get it on Liquid Fuels. Tom is willing to sign an affidavit to confirm the township has been working on and maintaining certain roads for 21 years to get them put on Liquid Fuels. KLH has a list of all the roads. Will have to survey Goat Hill Road.

Comments:

*Kasey Duran – Are we fixing Point Pleasant Road potholes soon? Range will put gravel in for now. We can go after their road bonds if we have to. They should be fixing road as they go.

*ETC trying to expand. Kasey thinks they are going to try and do it illegally without permits.

*We filed 2 nuisance citations for noise already. They have up to 2 years. They are possible just paying the fines. The board can reach out to DEP.

*Chief LaRue thanked Tom for all his years of service and all of his knowledge. This is his last meeting.
